## **JUNK, APPLIANCES, FURNITURE, YARD DEBRIS & BUILDING WASTE**

*Don't be left holding the bag.....*

- ✓ All items must be placed along the street in the city's right-of-way prior to the crews stopping at each residence.
- ✓ Crews are not responsible for picking up items that are not in place when they stop for pick up.
- ✓ To assure items will be picked up; residents may place items at the curbside beginning April 5;
- ✓ Leaves, grass and clippings must be bagged.
- ✓ Other Yard Debris must be bundled and tied with degradable string or twine, the bundle shall not be larger than four (4) inches in diameter or four (4) feet in length.
- ✓ Building waste is limited to debris resulting from a property owner's or tenant's home improvement project and may include lumber, plywood, siding, drywall, concrete rubble, windows, etc.

### **ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE PICKED UP AT CURBSIDE**

- ✓ Household garbage, Tires, Batteries, Motor Oil, Oil Based Paint, Varnish, Paint Thinner, etc.
- ✓ Items that are too large or too heavy to be loaded into the trash compacter.

### **\*Items accepted at the Grove Wastewater Treatment Plant\***

(Turn N at 3<sup>rd</sup> Street/S Cherokee Intersection and go approx. 2 miles North to the plant entrance)

## **FREE TIRE DISPOSAL**

**April 11-15 - 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.**



Residents of Grove and Delaware County may dispose of up to 25 tires per household.
