Cook reported that, effective as of November 2023, the State legislature passed a new bill allowing the State of Oklahoma to pay/reimburse municipalities for gas line relocation(s) when involved in a state highway widening project.

Douthit reported that GMSA has a customer South of Honey Creek that is rejecting the meter readers from entering his backyard to read his meter. Douthit wanted the Board to be prepared should they get any calls from the property owner because GMSA is getting ready to send him a letter stating they will be terminating his service if he doesn't comply with the policy.
